# Euro 15,000,000,000 Euro Medium Term Note Programme

This supplement (the "**Third Supplement**") is supplemental to and must be read in conjunction with the base prospectus dated 12 June 2023 which has been granted approval number 23-214 on 12 June 2023 as supplemented by the supplement dated 22 September 2023 which received approval number 23-407 on 22 September 2023 and by the second supplement dated 10 November 2023 which received approval number 23-469 on 10 November 2023 (the "**Base Prospectus**") by the *Autorité des marchés financiers* (the "**AMF**"), prepared by the ALD ("**ALD**" or the "**Issuer**") with respect to its Euro 15,000,000,000 Euro Medium Term Note Programme (the "**Programme**").

Terms defined in the Base Prospectus have the same meaning when used in this Third Supplement.

The Base Prospectus as supplemented constitutes a base prospectus for the purposes of Article 8 of Regulation (EU) 2017/1129 of the European Parliament and of the European Council of 14 June 2017, as amended (the "**Prospectus Regulation**"). This Third Supplement has been prepared in accordance with Article 23 of the Prospectus Regulation. Application has been made for approval of this Third Supplement to the AMF in its capacity as competent authority under the Prospectus Regulation.

This Third Supplement has been produced for the purposes of (i) incorporating by reference the January 2024 Press Release (as defined herein) and (ii) updating the section "General Information".

Save as disclosed in this Third Supplement, there has been no other significant new factor, material mistake or material inaccuracy relating to information included in the Base Prospectus (including information incorporated by reference) which is material in the context of the Programme since the publication of the Base Prospectus and which may affect the assessment of the Notes. To the extent that there is any inconsistency between (a) any statement in this Third Supplement and (b) any other statement in the Base Prospectus, the statements in this Third Supplement shall prevail.
